



IHP has been and will continue to monitor developments with the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and recommendations from health officials for mitigating community spread and exercising social distancing. Due to recent recommendations from health officials to exercise social distancing and limiting groups of 10 or more, **IHP employees are working remotely from home starting March 18th through April 30th.**
